

As of Monday, September 14, 2020, all children 18 years old and younger, in the town of Fairfield are eligible for lunch (all schools), and breakfast (at Holland Hill, McKinley, and all Middle and High Schools), at no charge. A la carte items such as snacks and juice will be available at full price.

Hybrid Elementary Level (PK - 5)

A School Store has been created in Campus Parent called AM Cohort Pre-Order and PM Cohort Pre-Order where parents will pre-order meals by 1:00 p.m. for the following school day. Pre-orders are requested to ensure an adequate number of meals are prepared. Please use the following link, <u>School Store Getting Started for Parents</u>, for instructions to pre-order. There will be no charge to your child's meal account.

Elementary lunches will be distributed to both AM and PM cohorts before dismissal. Lunches will not be eaten in school. Please note, students are not permitted to eat on the bus, as face coverings must be worn.

Hybrid Secondary Level (6 - 12)

Students will eat lunch in school on days they are in attendance. There will be no charge for the first lunch. Second lunches and a la carte snacks and beverages will be charged at full price.

Remote Learning Academy (RLA) and Hybrid Remote Days

RLA students are eligible for curbside pickup of meals from 10:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. each day school is in session. RLA parents will pre-order meals in the School Store called RLA Food Service Pre-Order.

Hybrid students on remote days are eligible for curbside pickup of meals from 10:00 a.m. - 10:30 a.m. for remote learning school days.

Please note that the USDA waiver is temporary until December 31, 2020 and is subject to the availability of funding. Parents must submit a Free and Reduced-priced School Meal Application to determine if your family may qualify for benefits when the free meal waiver ends.
